Maytag recalls dishwashers because of fire risk

Maytag is recalling 2.3 million Maytag and Jenn-Air brand dishwashers sold between July 1997 and 2001 because they pose a fire hazard. The Consumer Product Safety Commission said Maytag has received 135 reports of dishwasher fires. Four injuries have been reported. The hazard: Liquid rinse-aid can leak from the dishwasher dispenser and come into contact with the dishwashers internal wiring which can short circuit and ignite. The recall involves undercounter and portable plastic tub dish washers. To see if your dishwasher is affected go to www.repair.maytag.com.

The recall includes some Maytag and Jenn-Air models rated during those years. Consumers should stop using the recalled dishwashers immediately even if they do not use liquid rinse-aid and disconnect the electric supply by shutting off the fuse or circuit breaker. They should contact Maytag for a free in-home repair or a \$75 cash-back reimbursement on a new Maytag. Go to www.cpsc.gov to see all dishwasher recalls.

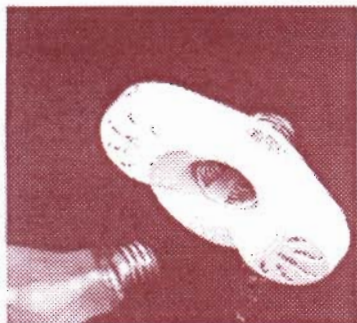

Dryers and washing machines were involved in one out of every 25 home structure fires reported to U.S. fire departments. Dryers and washing machines were involved in an average of 13,300 home structure fires per year. These fires caused an average of 10 deaths, 280 injuries and \$97 million in direct property damage per year. Clothes dryers and washing machines were involved in 4% of the home fires, clothes dryers accounted for 93% of the fires. The leading cause of home clothes dryer and washer fires was failure to clean (30%). Almost one third (31%) of these fires started with the ignition of clothing. In one quarter of them (24%), dust, fiber, or lint was the first item ignited.

TODDLER CALL SAVES MOM

Fairbanks, Alaska A toddler knew to call 911 when his mother collapsed and lost consciousness. Little Tony Sharpe was home with his mother, Courtenay, on April 10 when she blacked out during a gall bladder attack.

The four year old went to the phone and reached the North Star Volunteer Fire Department by dialing the emergency number. He told a dispatcher: "Mommy is sick, Mommy needs an ambulance. Mommy fell over. She is sleeping", according to a recording of the call.

"Can you call the ambulance?" he continued. "When Daddy gets here, Daddy will see if there's something wrong with Mommy." The boy then described the family's apartment building, which is white with a blue roof. Courtenay Sharpe was conscious and barely able to speak when firefighters arrived.

Her son had practiced dialing 911 countless times in one of his favorite books, "**Its Time to Call 911:What to do in an Emergency.**" The interactive book rewards its reader with a blast of emergency sirens and a cheery " good job" when 911 is punched into the key pad. "You know kids," Courtenay Sharpe said, "Once they latch onto a book, they want the same story read to them over and over again. After awhile, he pretty much knew the book by heart"
